Home to Banksy, Bristol has a thriving art scene. Many exhibitions are held across the year at multiple art galleries, museums and contemporary art centres.

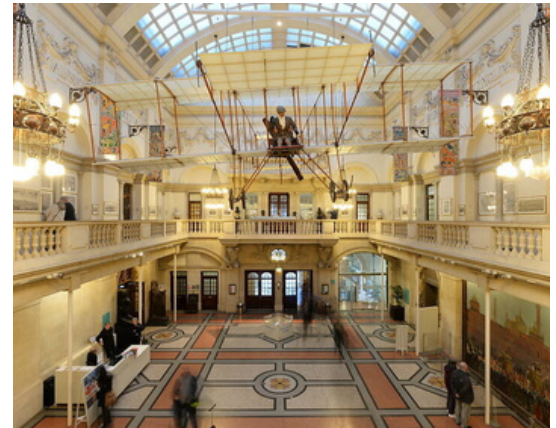
